Intertek performs the evaluation of conformity based on a random sampling of their products and on testing of limited parameters through risk assessment approach. The applicant agrees to take responsibility and acknowledges that they are aware of the customs legislative and regulatory requirements governing the import of their products and commit to comply with those requirements.
