Dear colleagues,

Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Surveillance presents its compliments to you and informs of the following.

The 47th Apimondia International Apicultural Congress of the International Federation of Beekeepers' Associations is planned to be held in September 2021 in the Republic of Bashkortostan (the Russian Federation), where representatives of more than 100 countries and organizations are planning to participate, according to the received list from the organizers (hereinafter referred to as the List), attached to the letter.

In connection with this, we inform you that the import of the products regulated by the state veterinary service, including honey and apicultural products, from foreign countries to the Eurasian Economic Union territory is carried out in accordance with the Unified veterinary (veterinary and sanitary) requirements for products that are subject to veterinary control (supervision) (hereinafter referred to as the Requirements) approved by the Decision of the Customs Union Commission No. 317 dated June 18, 2010 (hereinafter referred to as the Decision).

The veterinary and sanitary requirements for the import into the EAEU customs territory and (or) for the movement between its member countries of natural honey and apicultural products are regulated by Chapter 30 of the Requirements.

Natural honey and apicultural products, under the Decision, must be accompanied by an authorization issued by Rosselkhoznadzor and a veterinary certificate: Form No. 30 "Veterinary certificate for natural honey and other apicultural products exported to the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union" approved by the Decision of the Customs Union Commission No. 607 dated April 07, 2011 or must be accompanied by a certificate form agreed on a bilateral basis between the Russian Federation and the country or CU/EAEU and the country, as published on the official website of the Service at <https://www.fsvps.ru/fsvps/importExport/vetlist.html>

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In order to obtain an authorization from Rosselkhoznadzor for the import into the Russian Federation under the Administrative Regulation of the Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Surveillance to provide a public service to issue authorizations for the import into the Russian Federation and the export from the Russian Federation, as well as for the transit through its territory of animals, animal products, pharmaceutical products for veterinary use, animal feed and feed additives approved by the Order of the Ministry of Agriculture of Russia No. 404 dated November 07, 2011 (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation), Rosselkhoznadzor must receive a letter with information in accordance with Annex No. 2 to the Regulation (please kindly find attached) from the organizers of the specified exhibition or the Embassy of the exporting country in the Russian Federation.

Border veterinary control will be carried out in the places chosen by the customs authorities, primarily, in fixed warehouses for temporary storage (SVKh) or within the territory of the exhibition facilities at the temporary customs control area.

After the exhibition, the exhibited products are subject to transportation from the territory of the Russian Federation or must be destroyed. An exhibition participant must decide on the destruction of the products together with regional veterinary authorities of the Russian Federation depending on the place of the exhibition and the destruction.

You are kindly requested to communicate these requirements to the concerned organizations specified in the list and other participants of foreign economic activity.

We avail ourselves of this opportunity to renew to you the assurances of our highest consideration.

## INFORMATION TO PROVIDE IN THE APPLICATION LETTER

List of amending documents  
(as amended by the Orders of the Ministry of Agriculture of Russia  
No. 268 dated July 08, 2013,  
No. 496 dated October 31, 2016)

### I. To issue an authorization for the import of animals and animal genetic material

1. Last name, first name and (if any) patronymic name of the private person (importer) or full name of the legal person (importer);

2. Last name, first name and (if any) patronymic name of the private person (recipient) or full name of the legal person (recipient of regulated goods in the Russian Federation), its registered address or legal address and TIN.

It is not allowed to indicate several recipients in an application letter;

3. Name of regulated goods (biological species) and their CN FEA code (first 4 characters).

It is allowed to indicate several species belonging to the same genus of mammals, birds or other animals in an application letter;

4. Quantity of regulated goods and units of their measurement for each item;

5. Exporting country.

It is not allowed to indicate several exporting countries in an application letter;

6. Origin of regulated goods:

environmental;

bred or grown in artificial conditions;

It is not allowed to indicate information about animals of different origin in an application letter;

7. Last name, first name and (if any) patronymic name of the private person (supplier) or full name of the legal person (supplier);

8. Type of transport to be used for importing regulated goods;

9. Places of the change of vehicles (if applicable), watering, feeding and resting (if applicable) to be used for importing animals.

It is allowed to indicate several alternative routes;

10. Veterinary control points through which the import into the Russian Federation is planned, place of customs clearance and route of transportation (in case of the import of regulated goods in transit through CIS or the Eurasian Economic Union member state, it is necessary to indicate a control point at the border of CIS or the Eurasian Economic Union member state).

(as amended by the Order of the Ministry of Agriculture of Russia No. 496 dated October 31, 2016)

It is allowed to indicate several control points;

11. Purpose of import: breeding, keeping, fattening, slaughter, import for sports, entertainment events.

It is not recommended to indicate information about animals imported for different purposes in an application letter;

12. Information confirming compliance with the conditions for quarantine implementation and further keeping of animals in the recipient farm;

13. Production capacity of the recipient establishment for importing animals for slaughter.

14. Address of place of quarantine implementation for animals in the exporting country, indicating administrative territory of the exporting country;

(clause 14 was introduced by the Order of the Ministry of Agriculture of Russia No. 496 dated October 31, 2016)

15. Region of the Russian Federation into which the import is planned.

It is not allowed to indicate several regions of the Russian Federation in an application letter into which the import is planned.

(clause 15 was introduced by the Order of the Ministry of Agriculture of Russia No. 496 dated October 31, 2016)

## II. To issue an authorization for the import of feed and feed additives

1. Information specified in clauses 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 8, 10 of section I of the Annex to the Administrative Regulation;

2. Name of regulated goods and their CN FEA code (first 4 characters);

5. Last name, first name, patronymic name of the person accompanying regulated goods;

6. Description of package corresponding to the level of the biological hazard of regulated goods;

7. Purpose of import: for laboratory testing, for scientific use, for use in biotechnology, registration tests;

8. Particulars of documents for recipient's right to work with regulated goods.

V. To import issue an authorization for the import of regulated goods, not relating to sections I to IV of the Administrative Regulation

4. Place of quarantine implementation in the Russian Federation indicating organization (if applicable);

It is not allowed to indicate information about several places of quarantine implementation in an application letter;

5. Types of transport to be used for the export of regulated goods;

6. Control points to be used for the export of regulated goods from the Russian Federation, place of customs clearance and route of transportation;

7. Information on the guarantees of compliance with veterinary requirements of the importing country;

8. Control point at the border of CIS or the Eurasian Economic Union member state (applicable to the export of regulated goods in transit through CIS or the Eurasian Economic Union member state).

2. Name of producing establishment (vessel), export number and its legal address or registration address (for onshore establishments);

3. Areas of catching (extraction).

X. To issue an authorization for the export of regulated goods with hazardous biological agents

1. Information specified in clauses 1, 4 of section I, clauses 2, 4, 5, 6, 9 of section IV, clause 4 of section V, clauses 5, 6, 7, 8 of section VII, clause 3 of section VIII of the Annex to the Administrative Regulation;

2. Purpose of export: for laboratory testing, for scientific use, for use in biotechnology, registration tests;

3. Particulars of documents for sender's right to work with regulated goods.

XI. To issue an authorization for the export of regulated goods, not relating to sections VII to X of the Administrative Regulation

(as amended by the Order of the Ministry of Agriculture of Russia No. 496 dated October 31, 2016)

1. Information specified in clauses 1, 4 of section I, clause 2 of section II, clause 4 of section V, clauses 5, 6, 7, 8 of section VII, clauses 2, 3 of section VIII of the Annex to the Administrative Regulation;

2. Registration number, accounting series and validity period of the document of state registration (applicable to the export of pharmaceutical products for veterinary use).
